Registration will be accepted up to 3 business days prior to each course. **Students are responsible for obtaining materials lists from the SCG in advance of each course.** Art class students should “dress for mess.” Students are expected to be on time for all classes and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Lectures or demonstrations will not be repeated for students who are tardy or absent. Students engaging in disruptive or inappropriate behavior may be dismissed from a session or course at the discretion of the instructor.

Fees, cancellation, and refund policies: The program may be cancelled if minimum enrollment is not met by three days prior to the beginning of the program. If a program is cancelled, registrants will be notified immediately and may choose to receive a refund or credit towards a future camp, class, or workshop. Credit must be used within the next session and cannot be converted to a refund at a later date. If a registrant withdraws five (5) business days or more from the first day of the program, a \$20 fee will be assessed against the refund or credit. No refund or credit will be given for withdrawals less than five (5) business days of the first day of a program. Missed sessions will not result in a pro-ration of the total fee.
